



## **LORD WILLING, CHRIST WILL BE PREACHED AT THE MEMORIAL FOR JOHN McCAIN AT THE NATIONAL CATHEDRAL, (3101 WISCONSIN AVE., NW WASHINGTON, DC) SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup> 8:30 - 9:45AM**



John McCain has died. And on the heels of it, an amazing thing has happened which again lays bare the hearts of the people of this world. The news has become absolutely saturated with talk of how John McCain should properly be remembered. "He was a bona fide hero," some say. "He was a great American," others insist. Men all over this world are clacking at keyboards, ironing and hanging bunting, decorating desks and flying their flags at half-staff to make sure that John McCain is properly REMEMBERED. All the while, these same



men who feel the need to extoll and remember the virtues of some perceived 'hero' have utterly FORGOTTEN GOD, which is absolutely the worst thing a man, or a people, or a nation, can do. *The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God.* (Ps. 9:17) It is of a certainty that, when a man quits this earth, he then goes to what the Bible calls his '*long home*' (Eccl. 12:5). This means either heaven or hell – there is no middle ground and there are no alternatives. When a man 'forgets God' in his brief vapor of a temporal life, he will be 'turned into hell' in eternity. As much as he is touted as a 'great conservative' and 'quiet Christian,' John McCain led the charge in his generation for causing this nation to 'forget God,' and any memory of him should be tied to that as a stark warning for others. For nearly half a century, as a celebrated POW, congressman, senator and presidential candidate, McCain had one of the longest-running and most accessible bully pulpits in his generation. He always had the opportunity to publicly encourage this nation to obey the commandments of God. He always had the opportunity to encourage his fellow citizens to believe on the Lord Jesus Christ. Remembering God as the universal sovereign, and therefore obeying HIS laws, is the only important remembrance. *Remember now thy Creator in the days of thy youth, while the evil days come not, nor the years draw nigh, when thou shalt say, I have no pleasure in them... Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil.* (Eccl. 12:1,13,14)

John McCain has quit this earth, and has probably, by any outward indicia of the matter, entered hell at that same instant. His life and death serve as another stark warning to men of high places, and of ambition, and who seek riches and social honor, and fond remembrances of themselves: **REMEMBER THY CREATOR!** Repent of your sins against Him! Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ! Do NOT follow McCain's poor example.
