



Counting Crows is a Rock Band that has enjoyed international fame and success for nearly three decades. Their name comes from the old British divinity nursery rhyme “One for Sorrow”, which is a pseudo-religious tale of superstition. Even as they have chased worldly mammon and sin, they stumbled upon a tiny nugget of truth in their song “Big Yellow Taxi”: “You don't know what you've got ‘til it's gone...” A simple truth – especially regarding your never dying soul which could be required of you at any moment, at which time, your



opportunity to repent will be gone, *“For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.”* (1Thessalonians 5:3). Seeing that we live amongst a generation much like those of Noah and Lot, we see plainly that the time is short and destruction is coming:

“And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man. They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all. Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded; But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all. Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of man is revealed.” (Luke 17:26-30)
