

He markets himself as an animal lover, loving doting father, loving husband, lover of women's rights (uses his great grandmother's surname as his first name, which was his given middle name), and all around good ole boy. He has been nominated for 36 awards for his 8 albums and has won 8 of those awards. Using the materials from his 8 albums, he has toured each year since 2006. He opens for the biggest names in country music and promotes with good pay, high profile products, such as "5-hour energy". Further, he has appeared in 6 TV shows as himself, including "The Voice". One of his biggest charitable causes is American servicemen. He has hundreds of thousands of fans in the US and worldwide, that faithfully follow and support him. He owns his own bar in Nashville, "Whiskey Row", which some of his fans frequent on a regular basis. He promotes the celebration of Christmas, and particularly, the "Elf on the Shelf". He has a net worth of more than 30 million. All of this is meant to demonstrate the considerable platform and power that this man wields that he could and should be using to promote the truth about his Maker.
