# Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. Let's view some of this week's judgments from the proper perspective:

On Tuesday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, a 21-year-old gunman went on a shooting spree in the Atlanta, Georgia area. He targeted three massage parlors and murdered eight people. Six of the victims were women of Asian descent, one was a white man, and one was a white woman. The shooter began at Youngs Asian Massage Parlor around 5 PM. He moved on to Gold Spa, 30 miles away, about an hour later; his last target was the Aromatherapy Spa across the street. Law enforcement stopped him on the highway by bumping the back of his car and causing him to crash. According to interviews with the killer conducted by investigators, he targeted massage parlors because he frequented those types of locations (if not those exact locations) for sexual activity. Apparently, he calls himself a Christian and had gone to rehab for "sex addiction." He also said he was on the way to Florida to attack "some kind of porn industry" when he was arrested.

You don't get to compound grievous sin upon sin. God and Christ have provided remedies to Satan's devices and lusts of the flesh, and they don't include murder. They include spiritual work made possible by the Spirit of God.

**"For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ." (2 Corinthians 10:3-5).**

**"Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God." (Hebrews 12:1).**
