Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2)** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

Occurring less than a week after the murderous shootings in Atlanta, a young man by the name of Ahmad Al Aliwi Alissa opened fire in a grocery store Monday morning in Boulder, Colorado, claiming 10 lives. Alissa used an AR556 pistol which he had purchased on March 16th. Sources indicate that Alissa was a troubled man, prone to anger and violence. This violence took place only 10 days after a judge blocked a ban placed on assault rifles passed by the city of Boulder in 2018 after the mass shooting which took place at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida which took the lives of 17 people. Let this be clear: this is a work of God Almighty. All things that happen are by His hand and were decreed to happen by His unchanging will. President Biden urged Congress to take action on tightening the laws around gun control, stating “We have to act.” Mr. President, it would be more prudent for you to urge this nation you have been given charge over to turn from their sin with great fear for the heinous crimes against the Living God. Put away abortion, same-sex marriage, false gods, fornication, adultery, and divorce, and every other sin that plagues this nation. There will be no peace for the wicked. **“But the wicked are like the troubled sea, when it cannot rest, whose waters cast up mire and dirt. There is no peace, saith my God, to the wicked.” (Isaiah 57:20-21)**

“If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also. Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.
