## Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. **“Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they are a rebellious house.” (Ezekiel 12:2)** This entire world is a rebellious house! Therefore, the Lord, the God of Israel, is punishing the people of it! Let’s view some of this week’s judgments from the proper perspective:

This week amidst growing cries for tax and government reform, a report stemming from illegally leaked IRS tax documents put the atrocity of the filthy rich on full display. For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.” (1 Timothy 6: 6 - 11), “Riches profit not in the day of wrath: but righteousness delivereth from death.” (Proverbs 11:4), “Wisdom is good with an inheritance: and by it there is profit to them that see the sun. For wisdom is a defence, and money is a defence: but the excellency of knowledge is, that wisdom giveth life to them that have it. Your love of money has brought you to great sin and bankrupted your souls; Judgment is around the corner, and your money will not pay your soul’s debt - Repent. To you poor, look not upon the rich as though they can save you. Their money will not save their own souls, much less yours. God has blessed you with a want of temporal needs that you might rely upon Him and not yourselves as the rich do. **“Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth... But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, ... For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. (Matthew 6:19-21).** No law, policy or reform will fix the greed of man. Turn unto God who only can straighten that which is crooked.

Additionally, as the abomination known as “Pride Month” rages on, this week marks the 5<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Pulse nightclub shooting wherein the Lord God Almighty required the souls of 50 of His enemies for their wicked deeds against Him.
