Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

Reading the headlines this week could only elicit shame from knowing that these events are taking place in our country. The Parkland School shooter who murdered 17 people in cold blood was sentenced to life in prison this week as opposed to receiving the death penalty. Families of the slain expressed outrage at the verdict as their children did not get the 'justice they deserved'. There was no justice in either option as neither acknowledged God Almighty as the only source of truth and justice. The true affront to justice is to God Almighty as He alone declared murder a sin and the death sentence on any murderer: **“And he that killeth any man shall surely be put to death.” (Leviticus 24:17).** There is no mercy in this ruling - you have only shown that there are no real consequences to murder. As such, within hours of the verdict a 15-year-old murdered five on the streets of Raleigh, North Carolina in what so far appears to have no tangible motive. In addition to this, a teen in San Antonio, Texas remains in critical condition after a police-officer-involved shooting. The officer believed the teen's vehicle, sitting in a McDonalds parking lot at 10:45pm, to have been a stolen vehicle that had previously fled from him. Without following the law or protocol the officer ripped the car door open and demanded the teen (eating a cheeseburger) out of the vehicle. The child responded by putting the car in reverse and fleeing, upon which the officer drew his gun and began shooting at the vehicle, leaving the child in critical condition. The officer has been fired and now charged for his violent actions. **“And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse any falsely; and be content with your wages.” (Luke 3:14)** This rebellious child has met the recompense of his actions; obey those who have authority over you. **“And whosoever shall compel thee to go a mile, go with him twain.” (Matthew 5:41), “Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward.” (1 Peter 2:18)**

In similar news, the God-hating, hard-hearted liar, Alex Jones, was ordered to pay nearly \$1 billion in damages to family members of the Sandy Hook school shooting victims for his violence-inducing lies. **“A naughty person, a wicked man, walketh with a froward mouth. He winketh with his eyes, he speaketh with his feet, he teacheth with his fingers; Frowardness is in his heart, he deviseth mischief continually; he soweth discord. Therefore shall his calamity come suddenly; suddenly shall he be broken without remedy. These six things doth the Lord hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, A false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.” (Proverbs 16: 12-19)** This will not be the end of this judgment; not because of appeals and the obvious inability of most anyone to pay a billion dollars, but because Alex Jones will answer to the LORD. **“A false witness shall not be unpunished, and he that speaketh lies shall not escape” (Proverbs 19:5)** Lastly, after more than a year, the January 6 committee has voted to directly subpoena former President Donald Trump to testify to his violent attempted coup on January 6. **“A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise man keepeth it in till afterwards. If a ruler hearken to lies, all his servants are wicked...The king that faithfully judgeth the poor, his throne shall be established for ever. The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame. (Proverbs 29:11-15)**

These shameful events are a reflection of the hearts of the American people. Your leaders and policies are wicked because you, the people, are wicked. You have taught your children the lie that they will not be held accountable to anyone for anything, much less, that God will judge them. For generations the commandments of God have been set at naught and children have been left to their own devices, yet you feign outrage when one of the monsters you've created behaves as such. You have sewn in rebellion and now you are reaping destruction. You will either serve God or you will continue to suffer.
