Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week. The Word of the Lord provides an appropriate standard through which we may view them from a proper perspective:

This week, the United States House of Representatives passed a \$95 billion foreign aid bill to support the devastation caused by the wars in Ukraine, Israel, and other U.S. allies. \$61 billion of that was apportioned for Ukraine. The passing was met with cheering and waving of Ukrainian flags on the House floor, which was met by other Representatives as objectionable, leading some to seek making foreign flags prohibited within the House chambers. Meanwhile, the bill has now been sent to the Senate for approval. President Biden promised to sign the bill as soon as it is passed, urging the Senate “to quickly send this package to [his] desk” so that he can sign it into law and then “send weapons and equipment to Ukraine to meet their urgent battlefield needs.” The people in this nation, as demonstrated by these heads of the country, have turned their back on God and think they can divert His will by tossing money at any issue and attempting to throw their weight around to bully other countries in the world into submitting instead of seeking the Lord for peace and deliverance from evil. **“In thy filthiness is lewdness: because I have purged thee, and thou wast not purged, thou shalt not be purged from thy filthiness any more, till I have caused my fury to rest upon thee. I the LORD have spoken it: it shall come to pass, and I will do it; I will not go back, neither will I spare, neither will I repent; according to thy ways, and according to thy doings, shall they judge thee, saith the Lord GOD.”** (Ezekiel 24:13-14)

What a gross display of human hubris as well as a lack of glorifying God! Republican Representative Michael McCaul from Texas stated, “The eyes of the world are upon us, and history will judge what we do here and now.” Mr. McCaul, you have forgotten that the eyes of the Lord your God are upon you, and He will judge all that you have and will ever do before His judgment seat. And the children of Israel said unto the LORD, We have sinned: do thou unto us whatsoever seemeth good unto thee; deliver us only, we pray thee, this day. And they put away the strange gods from among them, and served the LORD: and his soul was grieved for the misery of Israel.”** (Judges 10:10-16)
