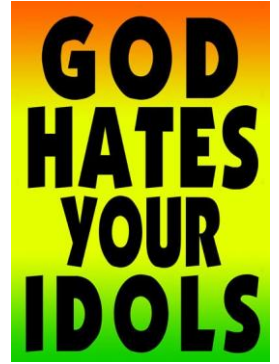

He has given you the prosperity and fame you have received, by no means of your own doing. Why? For His providence. He builds up and tears down. **(Romans 9:17-22)** He declares the beginning from the ending. **(Isaiah 46:9,10)** He kills, and he makes alive. **(1 Samuel 2:6-10)** All facets of this world are engineered for His glorification and the entire creation obeys His will. It cannot



change because He does not change. **(Malachi 3:1-5)** You will be made to account for every moment you spend on this earth. Redeem the time. **(Ephesians 5:15-20)**

“Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.” Revelation 4:11

Now those in attendance, you may say, isn't this a bit much? Can't we simply enjoy a little music and a night out with our family and friends? What's wrong with that? Nothing inherently when done in moderation and with a thankful spirit and acknowledgment of God's graciousness. **(Ecclesiastes 3)** The issue arises when you make an idol out of the music, the people, or the pursuit of any of these worldly things. Idolatry is putting anything above God. **“Their land also is full of idols; they worship the work of their own hands, that which their own fingers have made:” (Isaiah 2:8)** Furthermore, from these men's perspective, the error comes from the lack of use of these talents in service to their King. **(Matthew 25:14-30)** Unto whom much is given, much is required. **(Luke 12:41-53)** Remember this conclusion from the preacher in Ecclesiastes: **“I said in mine heart, Go to now, I will prove thee with mirth, therefore enjoy pleasure: and, behold, this also is vanity. I said of laughter, It is mad: and of mirth, What doeth it? ... I gathered me also silver and gold, and the peculiar treasure of kings and of the provinces: I gat me men singers and women singers, and the delights of the sons of men, as musical instruments, and that of all sorts. So I was great, and increased more than all that were before me in Jerusalem: also my wisdom remained with me. And whatsoever mine eyes desired I kept not from them, I withheld not my heart from any joy; for my heart rejoiced in all my labour: and this was my portion of all my labour. Then I looked on all the works that my hands had wrought, and on the labour that I had laboured to do: and, behold, all was vanity and vexation of spirit, and there was no profit under the sun.” (Ecclesiastes 2)**

We beseech you: reconcile yourselves to the Lord. Heed the sounding trumpet. **(Ezekiel 33:1-20)**
