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Signs of the Times: Shining Bible Light on Current Events

The Lord has wrought many blessed judgments in the world this week which can be seen plainly by any who have been given eyes to see, ears to hear, and a heart to understand by the gracious hand of God. Let's view some of this week's judgments from the proper perspective:

This week was the 25th anniversary of the terrorist attacks on the twin towers in New York City on September 11th, 2001.

There were present at that season some that told him of the Galilaeans, whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. And Jesus answering said unto them, Suppose ye that these Galilaeans were sinners above all the Galilaeans, because they suffered such things? I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish. Or those eighteen, upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, and slew them, think ye that they were sinners above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem? I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.
(Luke 13:1-5)

Twenty-five years ago, the Lord God rendered the lesson of the Tower of Siloam to this country twice for good measure: first on its South Tower, and then on its North Tower a few minutes later. And from that day to this, you have persisted in soaking the land with blood and defiling it; with the blood of your enemies, whom God told you to love (*Matthew 5:44*); with the blood of your neighbors near and far, whom God told you to love (*Matthew 22:39*); with the blood of your unborn children, that fruit of the womb which is His reward (*Psalms 127:3*); with the blood of your born children, which heritage is God's, and whom He instructed you to raise in His nurture and admonition (*Ephesians 6:4*). You sinners above all men, who drink sin like water and who work iniquity till your backs give out, hear the word of the LORD:

So ye shall not pollute the land wherein ye are: for blood it defileth the land: and the land cannot be cleansed of the blood that is shed therein, but by the blood of him that shed it. Defile not therefore the land which ye shall inhabit, wherein I dwell: for I the LORD dwell among the children of Israel. (Numbers 35:33-34)

Hear the word of the LORD, ye children of Israel: for the LORD hath a controversy with the inhabitants of the land, because there is no truth, nor mercy, nor knowledge of God in the land. By swearing, and lying, and killing, and stealing, and committing adultery, they break out, and blood toucheth blood. Therefore shall the land mourn, and every one that dwelleth therein shall languish, with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven; yea, the fishes of the sea also shall be taken away. Yet let no man strive, nor reprove another: for thy people are as they that strive with the priest. Therefore shalt thou fall in the day, and the prophet also shall fall with thee in the night, and I will destroy thy mother.
(Hosea 4:1-5)

Even as your sins have taken on every stripe, speckle, and ring strake, so has God opened His armory and multiplied horrors upon this nation and world, rewarding you all according to your ways as He deems good. In His mercy, He has yet given you room to turn from your wickedness and obey Him. Nevertheless *beware*:

But they mocked the messengers of God, and despised his words, and misused his prophets, until the wrath of the LORD arose against his people, till there was no remedy. (2 Chronicles 36:16)

Woe to you who have hardened your hearts against the Lord and His word. The destruction of this world is imminent; you must believe on Christ, repent of your sins, and seek the Lord with humility. "For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon a desolation: they shall drive out Ashdod at the noon day, and Ekron shall be rooted up. Woe unto the inhabitants of the sea coast, the nation of the Cherethites! the word of the LORD is against you; O Canaan, the land of the Philistines, I will even destroy thee, that there shall be no inhabitant." (Zephaniah 2:4-5)
